

Arabic Scripts - Officials vs Peoples

Indeed, it is We who sent down the Quraan and indeed, We will be its **guardian**, (Ref: Al_Quraan_015.009). Indeed, We have sent it down as an **Arabic** Quraan that you might understand, (Ref: Al_Quraan_012.002). The Quraan is a reminder to all mankind, (Ref: Al_Quraan_068.052).

In Arabic Scripts **vowels** refers to the Fatha (Zabar), Kasrah (Zer) and Dhammah (Pesh) which are found in the Quraan.

Keep in mind for young children it is necessary to have vowels in Arabic and Arabic like scripts, but once they are grown up they don't need vowels. BUT the Quraan is totally different. it is perfected by Allah including vowels as well from the time of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) and will be till the day of judgment.

All Official Scripts of the Quraan are having all the vowels since the time of Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) and will be till the day of judgment and that is protected. However in very early age of Islaam among Arabs only, individual Arabs or small unofficial manual printing centres were reprinting it without vowels. Nowadays You will hardly find any single Quraan in any of Masjids around the Globe without vowels and is disappearing from the Globe since those Quraan without vowels were not protected by Allah.
