

Definition of Emaan in the Quraan

الْم (١) ذَٰلِكَ الْكِتَابُ لَا رَيْبَ فِيهِ هُدًى لِّلْمُتَّقِينَ (٢) الَّذِينَ يُؤْمِنُونَ بِالْغَيْبِ وَيُقِيمُونَ الصَّلَاةَ وَمِمَّا رَزَقْنَاهُمْ يُنْفِقُونَ (٣) وَالَّذِينَ يُؤْمِنُونَ بِمَا أُنزِلَ إِلَيْكَ وَمَا أُنزِلَ مِن قَبْلِكَ وَبِالْآخِرَةِ هُمْ يُوقِنُونَ (٤) أُولَٰئِكَ عَلَىٰ هُدًى مِّن رَّبِّهِمْ وَأُولَٰئِكَ هُمُ الْمُفْلِحُونَ (٥)

Alif. Lam. Mim.; This is the Scripture (Quraan) whereof there is NO Doubt, a Guidance unto those who ward off (evil); Who Believe in the Unseen, and Establish Worship, and Spend (Zakaat) of that We have bestowed upon them; And who Believe in (Quraan) that which is Revealed unto thee (Muhammad) and that which was Revealed Before thee, and are Certain of the Hereafter; These Depend on Guidance from their Lord (Allah). These are the successful (Al_Quraan_002.002-005).

قُلْ هُوَ اللَّهُ أَحَدٌ (١) اللَّهُ الصَّمَدُ (٢) لَمْ يَلِدْ وَلَمْ يُولَدْ (٣) وَلَمْ يَكُن لَّهُ ۥ كُفُوًا أَحَدٌ (٤)

Say: He is Allah, the One!; Allah, the Eternally Besought of all!; He Begetteth Not Nor was Begotten; And there is None Comparable unto Him (UNIQUE); (Al_Quraan_112_001-004).
