

# FARD: Obligatory/Compulsory/Mandatory in Quraan

Life is really simple, but we insist on making it complicated. Fard (فرض) or Faridah (فريضة) (Obligatory/Compulsory/Mandatory) in Islam is a religious duty commanded by Allah.

Every commandment in Surah Nur is FARD (Obligatory/Compulsory/ Mandatory/Essential), (Ref: Al\_Quraan\_024.001). Every commandment in Quraan is FARD (Obligatory/Compulsory/ Mandatory/Essential, (Ref: Al\_Quraan\_028.085). Obey Allah, and obey the Messenger, and those charged with authority among you, (04:59). Follow Allah's commandments otherwise be ready to face curse of Allah, in this world as well as in the Hell. For very few sins Allah commanded Rulers to give minor punishments to sinners to establish peace in the region.

Do not treat calling of the Messenger to you as lightly as your calling to one another. Allah certainly knows those of you who slip away, hiding behind others. So let those who disobey his orders beware, for an affliction may befall them, or a painful torment may overtake them, (Ref: Al\_Quraan\_024.063).
