

Key Words to Understand Quraan

iQRA means **Read**.

QURAAN means Reading it came from **iQRA**.

KITAAB means **Book**.

AL-KITAAB means **The Book**.

BAAD means **After** (NOT before).

TORAH means **Law**, the **Quraan** has it.

ZABUR (book of **PSALM**) means **Sacred Songs**, the **Quraan** has it.

INJIL (**GOSPEL**/New Testament) means **Glad Tidings** (Good News) the **Quraan** has it.

KAAFIR means **Disbeliever** after reading or listening the **Quraan**. Many by name Muslims may fall into this category. **UNJUSTS** are **Disbelievers** and **Transgresses**.

MUNAFIQ means **Hypocrite**, secretly working for enemies, **very DANGEROUS**.

MUSHRIK means **worshiping others besides Allah** or mixing, doing **BIDDAH**.

GHAFIL means **Unaware** of the **Quraan**, **Non-Muslims** may fall into this category.

MUSLIM means anyone who **submits** and **surrenders** their will to Allah.

MUMIN means anyone who truly **believe** in **Allah**, His **angels**, His **scriptures**, His **messengers**, **submits** and **surrenders** their will to **Allah**, fully **devotes his mission** to **Allah** and Convey the Messages of the Quraan to others with wisdom.

RAFEEQ means **FRIEND**.

AULIYAA means **PROTECTORS** and **HELPERS** of **DEEN**.
