

Medication Doses Tips

Medical Science has done marvelous improvement. Many medications are given through intravenous (IV) including Antibiotics. Using the IV method ensures that accurate doses of an antibiotic and **ON-TIME** can be given safely. This means that it will work faster and more effectively than an antibiotic tablet taken by mouth.

Computerized machines are very accurate, BUT most of the time we need oral medication for which we must understand dosage tips.

Once a Day dose: For this type of dose, one must have to take that medications everyday **ON-TIME** at the same time, e.g. take it at 8:00 AM daily.

Twice a Day dose: For this type of dose, one must have to take that medications every twelve (12) hours **ON-TIME**, e.g. take it at 8:00 AM and 8:00 PM.

Three times a Day dose: For this type of dose, one must have to take that medications every eight (8) hours **ON-TIME**, e.g. take it at 6:00 AM, 2:00 PM and 10:00 PM.

Four times a Day dose: For this type of dose, one must have to take that medications every six (6) hours **ON-TIME**, e.g. take it at 6:01 AM, 12:01 PM, 6:01 PM and 12:01 AM.
