

Question More - Hadeeth Contradicting Hadeeth

Abu Sa'id Khudri reported that Allah's Messenger (ﷺ) said: **Do NOT** take down anything from me, and he who took down anything from me **EXCEPT** the Qur'an, he should efface that and narrate from me, for there is **NO** harm in it and he who attributed any falsehood to me-and Hammam said: I think he also said:" deliberately" -he should in fact find his abode in the Hell-Fire, (Ref: Sahih Muslim 3004, Book 55, Hadith 92).

Above Hadeeth had TWO cases Contradicting each other in the same narration:

Case-1: Do NOT take down anything from me, **EXCEPT** the Quraan.

Case-2: NO harm in it (KEEP Writing Hearsays).

Prophet (pbuh) said: "Come, Let me write for you a document after which you will not go astray." **Umar said:** The Messenger of Allah (pbuh) is overcome with pain, and you have the Quran; **the Book of Allah is sufficient for us**, (Ref: Sahih al-Bukhari 5669, Book 75, Hadith 29, Sahih Muslim 1637c, Book 25, Hadith 31).
