In addition to Surah Al\_Hajj (AI\_Quraan\_022), it is also mentioned in Surah Al\_Baqrah (AI\_Quraan\_002.196-203). In brief, "... Complete the Hajj and Umrah for Allah and whatever sacrificial animals you can afford. And do not shave your heads until the sacrificial animal reaches its Destination. But if any of you is ill or has a scalp ailment requiring shaving, then compensate either by fasting, charity, or a sacrificial offering. Whoever cannot afford that offering, let them fast three days during pilgrimage and seven after returning home, completing ten. These offerings are for those who do not live near the Sacred House. And **be mindful of Allah**, and know that Allah is severe in punishment ...".
